Let us look at some important facts about being a member of EBN HOA.

- A homeowners association (HOA) is an organization that manages the rules and guidelines for a residential community, such as a condominium building, planned community or subdivision. HOAs are common in common-interest communities.
 Some of the things HOAs do includes:
 - Maintaining common areas: HOAs ensure that common areas, such as a community park are kept in good condition.
 - Enforcing rules: HOAs establish rules and regulations, called bylaws, for residents to follow.
 - Providing amenities: HOAs may provide amenities such as a clubhouse, swimming pool, tennis courts and more.
 - o Charging fees: HOAs collect dues from member homes.
 - Imposing fines: HOAs have legal power to impose fines for not complying with rules.
 - Placing liens: HOAs can place a lien on your home if you don't pay your fees or follow CC&Rs.
- When you buy a property in a community with an HOA, you are legally bound to follow the covenants, conditions, and restrictions (CC&Rs) that govern the community. You cannot opt-out of the HOA's authority.
- Covenants, conditions, and restrictions (CC&Rs) are a set of rules that govern how a piece of real estate can be used in a community (EBN). They are designed to protect property values and define what homeowners can and cannot do with their property. CC&Rs can include rules about:
 - Landscaping.
 - Parking
 - Home improvements.
 - Home design.
 - Other factors.
- CC&Rs are created by our HOA. CC&Rs are "run with the land," meaning they remain in effect even if the property is sold to a new owner.
- It is important to read the CC&Rs before buying a home in a planned community.
